## Your 2020 Census Checklist

Before you start responding to the census, gather the following information so you can complete the questionnaire easily.

- ✓ Individual code provided by the U.S. Census Bureau

(you can still respond without the code, but you will need to provide a valid physical address, not a P.O. box)

- ✓ First and last name, age, birth date, race, ethnicity, sex, and relationship to head of household

(count everyone who lives in the household, including non-family members)

- ✓ Whether you rent or own your house, apartment, or mobile home
- ✓ Telephone number

## March-April 2020

Los Angeles residents receive mailings and reminders to participate in the 2020 Census

## March-July 2020

Response window for all Angelenos

## April 1, 2020

Census Day

## May-July 2020

Census takers will visit the homes of non-responsive residents to encourage participation
